A34. SURCHARGE TO FUND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION
REIMBURSEMENT FEE

34.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

34.1.1 APPLICABILITY

All telecommunications carriers are required to apply California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) mandated Public Program surcharge rates and the CPUC Reimbursement Fee rate to intrastate services. The Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee Surcharge is for the purpose of funding the Public Utilities Commission and applies to the aggregate amount of customer billings associated with intrastate billings which appear on customers' bills.*

34.1.2 TERRITORY

Within the exchange areas of all exchanges as said areas are defined on maps filed as part of the tariff schedules.

34.2 RATES

As permitted by Public Utilities Code Section 492, and as required by CPUC Resolution T-16901, Ordering Paragraph 1, effective January 1, 2005, Sierra Telephone concurs with the Commission's Public Program all-end-user surcharges rates and the Reimbursement Fee rate as filed by Pacific Bell Telephone Company (d.b.a. AT&T California) (Pacific Bell/AT&T California) in its joint tariff for surcharges and fees. Sierra Telephone will apply the current surcharge and fee rates filed in the joint tariff to its respective end user bills until further revised.

For a list of the individual Public Program surcharges and Reimbursement Fee, and the current Commission-approved percentage surcharge and fee rates, refer to the Pacific Bell/AT&T California tariff Schedules Cal. *In 1983 the Legislature established the Public Utilities Commission Reimbursement Fee to be paid by utilities to fund their regulation by the Commission (Public Utilities PU Code Section 401-433). The surcharge to recover the cost of that fee is ordered by the Commission under authority granted by Public Utilities Code Section 433.

34.3 SPECIAL CONDITIONS

A. The monthly percentage applies to all intrastate recurring and non-recurring rates and charges for service provided under all of the Utility's tariff schedules excluding yellow page directory revenues, direct sales, detariffed services, federal and local excise taxes, and the following:

2. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A9 Public Access Line Service (PARTIAL) - Coin Sent Paid, Coin Station Service, Coin Person Service, and Debit Card Messages
3. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A14 Intrabuilding Network Cable
4. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A24 California Teleconnect Fund Surcharge
5. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A26 Universal Lifeline Telephone Service Surcharge
6. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A29 Inside Wire Maintenance Service
7. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A31 Products and Services for the Disabled Surcharge
8. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A32 California High Cost Fund Surcharge
9. Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. B1 Access Service
10. Message Telecommunications (PARTIAL) – Coin Sent Paid, Coin Station Service, and Coin Person Service
